



Drug and Alcohol Treatment Service (DATS): A collaboration between Mission Australia and Youth Involvement Council

The Drug and Alcohol Treatment Service provides

Free and confidential alcohol and other drug counselling and case management support for ages 8 to 14 years.

Our service adopts an evidence-based approach of harm reduction and trauma-informed practice which is delivered by a multidisciplinary team of Clinician, Case manager and Youth workers. The service supports young people to develop a positive self-image, gain confidence and to reduce risk taking behaviors associated with substance misuse.

Who is Eligible?

- Youth between the ages of 8 to 14 years of age.
- Who are currently using alcohol or drugs
- Alternatively, youth who are experiencing issues because of a significant other's AOD use (i.e. parents and family members).

How we can support:

- Counselling services
- Case management support available to both young adults and their families
- Outreach support
- Group activities
- Clinician available on-site at YIC
 Monday to Friday between 10 am
 to 6 pm.
- Referral to other support services
